

## Advisory Council Recruitment Outreach Strategies for SPR staff and existing AC members:

- 1. Begin with individual recruitment from your direct networks: Include friends, colleagues, community-based orgs, business contacts, and program partners. (email template provided)
- 2. Share the recruitment flyer electronically on social media, Nextdoor, and community blogs.
- 3. Include Advisory Council meeting times in your program brochure.
- 4. Post the recruitment flyer on community and coffee shop bulletin boards.
- 5. Table in the center or field during peak traffic times.
- 6. Promote the opportunity at special events.
- 7. Promote the opportunity after the special events.
- 8. Seek out individuals who are multi-lingual and speak the language of those in the community.
- 9. Reach out to older teens and young adults.
- 10. Invite interested members or program participants to your next AC meeting.
